The course aims to provide students with a basic understanding of the origins and evolution of the European integration process, the objectives, values, and principles of the EU, and its institutional framework. This is complemented by further exploration of specific sectors of EU law (linguistic rights, the EU and religions). During the lectures, selected cases from the jurisprudence of the Court of Justice of the European Union will also be analyzed and discussed.

Course Contents

The course will specifically address the following topics:

- Origins and evolution of the European integration process;
- The European Union: objectives, values, and principles;
- The institutional framework of the European Union;
- The competence system;
- Sources of EU law (primary law and other sources; secondary law);
- The judicial remedies system;
- The relationship with the legal systems of the Member States.
