Course Objective

The course is aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and is aimed at students who need to reach level B 1.

The student learns to understand the essential basics of a standard conversation (written and oral). These skills can also apply to working life as well as to short and simple information, light literary texts, straightforward, current topics.

By reaching language level B 1 , one gains the ability to use the German language independently and relatively fluently in everyday and professional contexts.

The foundation of this course is grammar and the development of a broad vocabulary. This includes reading, understanding, and analyzing texts as well as written and oral ~~con~~versation practice.
