Course Objectives

The course aims to introduce students to the study of professional communication in French and to academic writing in preparation for a dissertation. Through the reading and analysis of texts related to the field of professional communication, the course also aims to enrich students' vocabulary.

Course Content

1. Use of rhetoric, pragmatics, and sociolinguistic tools for writing texts of various types.
2. Study of the elements necessary for writing a bachelor's dissertation, such as methodology, bibliography, and writing standards.

Exam

Student assessment will be divided into two parts: a written exam and an oral presentation.
